* A multidisciplinary study is a single degree that focuses on two separate areas. Students seeking this degree will essentially work with the two advisors over the two concentrations selected, though one of these advisors will serve as a primary role. The primary advisor is the advisor listed first alphabetically by degree.

Example: If a student is seeking a Multidisciplinary degree in Biblical Studies and English, the primary advisor is Ken Young since Biblical Studies comes before English alphabetically.
