

Residence Hall Checklists

What to Bring:

- Alarm Clock (with a battery back-up).
- Bathroom caddy with bathroom/shower supplies.
- Bed linens (XL twin), mattress pad, blankets, comforter, pillow(s).
- Prescription medication.
- Flashlight, batteries.
- Laundry basket/bag and clothes hangers.
- Laundry supplies (detergent, fabric softener, iron, etc).
- Surge protector with a reset switch.
- Robe, bath towels, wash cloths, slippers, shower shoes.
- Social Security card.
- Small garbage can/bags.
- Daily appointment book/calendar.
- Dictionary/thesaurus.
- Framed photos of family & friends.
- Desk lamps (no halogen lights).
- Roll of tape or poster gum.
- Food storage containers/silverware/cups/plates/bowls.
- Basic cleaning supplies.

Optional Items:

- Backpack/messenger bag.
- Calculator Camera Computer/USB drive
- Basic medical kit.
- Plastic storage containers.
- Small folding clothes rack.
- Small stereo/headphones.
- Television/DVD player/video game system (North Residence Hall/JPCC suites w/living rooms have televisions that are provided. Cable is *NOT* provided).
- Lounge chair.
- Floor rug/bathmat.
- Mini-refrigerators (1 mini-fridge per room for electrical purposes, these are provided in the North Residence Hall/JPCC and the LLC).

What NOT to Bring:

- Alcohol/drugs and paraphernalia.
- Grills, halogen lamps, space heaters, sun/heat lamps.

- Glass bottled products.
- Candles, incense, potpourri burners.
- Dimmer switches.
- Ceiling fans.
- Electric blankets.
- Extension cords.
- Flammable holiday decorations
- Hot plates, coffee makers, candle warmers, or any other appliances with open heating coils or elements (single cup coffee makers such as Keurigs or similar products are permitted).
- Pets.
- Weapons, firearms, explosives, fire crackers, or anything that looks like or may be used as a weapon.
- Double-sided tape and duct tape.

****NOTE****

Students that wish to hang items on their walls such as posters, photos, or other items are encouraged to use 3M strips. Holes caused by nails, staples, or thumbtacks will be assessed as damages upon check-out and added to the students final billing statement as a damage charge.
