

ADMISSION CHECKLIST

In order to be admitted to SCU's Teacher Education Program the student must submit the following documents to the Education Department in the Adult Studies Building:

Successful completion of EDUC 2301 Introduction to Education
Professional Teacher Education admission application
Transcripts showing all college classes taken to date. Transcripts verify the student has the required 2.75 GPA for admission.
Passing score on the Oklahoma General Education Test (OGET).
No grade lower than a "C" in the major course work including any required General Education courses (verified by submitted transcripts)
No grade lower than a "C" in any Professional Education course (verified by submitted transcripts)
English Proficiency (no lower than a "C" in six hours of English Composition)
Philosophy of Education paper (completed in EDUC 2113 Foundations of Education)
Why Do I Want To Teach? Paper (300-350 words) (completed in EDUC 2113 Foundations of Education)
An approved background check within the last 12 months (usually completed in EDUC 2113 Foundations of Education)
Code of Ethics Form
Felony Check Form (included with admission application)
Evidence of work with children (Time Sheets and Reflections)
Disposition form #1 (self-evaluation)
Disposition form #2 (completed by faculty member of the student's choice)
Emergency Contact Form
Recommendation Letters (one from church official and/or faculty member and one from a faculty member)
Interview with Admissions Committee (included with admission application)
Foreign Language Competency Form

All materials will be reviewed by the Teacher Education Council (TEC). The TEC must approve the student's application before s/he will be admitted into the Teacher Education Program.
